A La Raza gang member was certified Wednesday to be tried in adult courts on murder charges in the Oct. 2 drive-by shooting of a woman while visiting friends.

State District Judge Robert Baum certified Fidel Marquez, now 17, in the shooting of Rani Goodgame, 18, at 6410 Grapevine in southwest Houston.

Javier Hernandez, 18, and Hector Gomez, 18, also await prosecution on murder charges.
